#### **Procedures:**

During Meet the Teacher, everyone will maintain social distancing guidelines. **One parent and one student will be allowed to enter the school building to meet the student's teacher.** Temperatures will be taken before entering the building to ensure the safety for all. Parents and students will be required to wear a mask before entering the building. Those who have not registered will be given an opportunity to complete their registration packets during this time. During Meet the Teacher, students will be able to drop off their supplies, sign their One:One Acceptable Use and Handbook Agreement for their district device, and finalize their transportation arrangements.

# **Device Check-Out Procedures:**

After the required GISD paperwork is completed for the One:One device, parents will be able to check out their student's GISD device during their Meet the Teacher block.

#### **Important Things to Consider and Bring:**

- Please make sure you bring your *ID/Driver's Licence*.
- Please bring your own *pen* with you, as we will be signing papers.
- Please make sure you and your child are wearing a *mask* when attending Meet the Teacher.
- Please bring your *patience* as there will be times where you may be waiting in line.
- We are keeping your safety and the safety of our staff in the forefront of all we do.
- You are welcome to bring your child's *school supplies* if you have them ready. Please bring any school supplies in one large disposable bag with your student's name.

## **Important Things to Practice Prior to the Start of School:**

- Buckling and unbuckling their seat buckles if they are going to be Car Riders.
- *Clearly* saying their first and last name.
- Wearing their mask.
- Opening and closing their lunch containers if you are choosing to send a lunch with them to school.
- Please have your child practice independently buttoning and unbuttoning their pants/belt for restroom breaks.
