To qualify for this scholarship, you must be a senior at Gonzales High School and for the past two years you must have been active in **2** of the following categories:

- Athletics, band, UIL Theatre OAP or Academics, or a member of a student organization or club such as art or student council.

Students who are active in two of these categories must have passed all classes consistently while involved in all of these extracurricular activities.

Students applying for the scholarship are required to *submit transcript and fact sheet*, have sponsor/coach/teacher sign off on participation in both of the activities they participate in including all the years active, and write a one to two page essay on how they kept up with their classes, how participating in these activities helped shape their character, and explain how the money will help with their higher education either in college or with vocational/certification training. Please share work experience if applicable.
