

GISD ONLINE INSTRUCTIONAL MODEL



Asynchronous Instruction: students engage in the learning materials on their own time, interacting intermittently with the teacher via their Chromebook or iPad

Assignments



- Clear instructional schedule
- Progress Monitoring
- No more packets/choice boards

Grades

- District grading policy applies- 70% passing percentage
- No more pass/fail
- Coursework/grading is separate from attendance progress measure



GISD's Online (At-Home) Model will follow TEA guidelines for Asynchronous instruction.

ATTENDANCE

Students marked present in 1 of 3 ways:

- Completion of assignments through Google Classroom within the defined instructional day
- Interaction with the student's teacher
- Data from Google Classroom showing progress made that day
- 90% Rule applies

INSTRUCTION

- Teacher pre-recorded videos for direct instruction. Same instruction received Onsite.
- Teacher office hours and feedback sessions required
- Daily interaction through Google Classroom, video conferencing, assignment completion

COLLABORATION

Successful online learning takes place when...

1. Districts and campuses provide a clear instructional plan and monitor student progress
2. Parents and guardians work with the district to monitor student progress and submission of assignments
