Starting Monday March 30, 2020, many of your assignments will be available online using the school district's online Edgenuity program. Please follow these instructions for online classes:

1. Go to [Edgenuity.com](https://www.edgenuity.com)

Near the top of the page is an orange "Log In" box. Click on the box.

2. Click on "Student Login"
3. Enter your student username and password.
