Sexual Health and Relationship Education - SHARE

The SHARE program is aligned with the Health TEKS and meets the TEXAS requirements for an abstinence-based curriculum. The instruction is delivered in a classroom setting. Students participate in interactive skits, discussions, games, and activities. Content used in the SHARE Program is age appropriate. Listed below are the topics covered during the program:

- teen pregnancy
- STDs
- healthy relationships/abuse and violence (unhealthy relationships)
- contraception (NOT a demonstration NOR promotion)

The Sexual Health And Relationship Education (SHARE) program will be presenting the abstinence-based sexual health curriculum program in 9th-12th grade classes on March 24th. Topics will include: abstinence, teen pregnancy, STDs, healthy relationships, abuse and violence in families and relationships, media influences and social media, pornography, sexting, and contraception (NOT a demonstration NOR promotion, but information about how various types of contraception work, actual use effectiveness rates, and any possible side effects/risks).

9th and 10th grade will focus on teen pregnancy and STDs

11th and 12th grade will focus on healthy relationships and contraception
