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Job Title: Multi-Skilled Storyteller Interns

WHO:

4 Paid Internship positions (Seniors Only)

4 Unpaid Internship positions (9th - 11th grade)

Pay \$7.25 hr Schedule 15-20 hours per week

Length of Time - School Year

Applications are due on Tuesday, August 22. Acceptance notifications will be sent Monday, August 25.

WHAT:

The intern will gain experience in communications strategy and public relations practices while working with the communications department to assist with writing projects, event planning, photography, web postings and other departmental functions. In addition, the intern will have the opportunity to build a professional portfolio by having their writing and photographs published on the web and in district publications. The internship program provides an excellent opportunity to gain professional experience and contribute in an active, demanding and dynamic public relations environment.

We are running this through our CTE program as part of a work-based learning opportunity.

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisites and no minimum GPA required.

There is an application and interview process that prospective students must successfully go through in order to be accepted. Upon initial acceptance, interns go through a probationary period to allow for accurate work assessments. Weekly meetings consist of lectures, workshops, professional guest speakers, and discussions. The students also work independently on their own time and with their peers to complete projects and assignments. Ideal candidates have a passion for journalism and digital communications, work collaboratively with others in a team setting, excel while working independently, and are eager to learn.

The specialties covered in the program consist of the following: journalism (including broadcast, print, and digital), communications, video production, marketing, public relations, media relations, crisis communications, event planning, social media, graphic design, business and real world skills such as interview techniques, ethics and professionalism.

Possible Team Projects

Podcast, newswriting, graphic design, video, social media, and the website team.

What is the time commitment for this program?

Approximately 15-20 hours
