Item #1. Call to Order

The Board of Trustees of the Gonzales Independent School District met Wednesday, July 26, 2023, at the Administrative Office Board Room, Gonzales, Texas. President, Ross Hendershot, III called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.

Item #3: New Business/Action Items:

- A. Discuss and Consider Action to Approve the Delegate/Delegate Alternate to the TASB Delegate Assembly

Dr. Elmer Avellaneda informed the board that it was time to approve a Delegate and Delegate Alternate. Each member school district is asked to name a Delegate and a Delegate Alternate to represent the views of the district and to attend the TASA/TASB Convention in Dallas this year.

Mr. Ross Hendershot, III made a motion with a second from Justin Schwausch to accept Josie Smith-Wright as Delegate, and Ashley Molina was named as the Delegate Alternate to the 2023-2024 TASB Delegate Assembly. The motion passed 7/0.

Item#4 Reports:

- A. Facilities Report

Dr. Elmer Avellaneda shared with the board the information he is bringing to the board is to inform them of the project information that has been obtained. Dr. A also introduced Casey

Sledge from Sledge Engineering, LLC. To give the board the Facility Update information that was gathered for the project that has been brought forward.

The board discussed options of an Athletic Complex, a CTE Building, and a new High School. Items were discussed and considered by the board. (Athletic Complex, District Wide Maintenance & Safety Security Projects were discussed) The board was asked to decide on what they wanted to do as to which projects they wanted to start working on.

Three propositions were discussed (1) Athletic Complex, which includes the soccer field, football field, Softball, & Baseball field (2) New High School (3) District Wide Safety & Security accessibility and Maintenance Project.

The Board will take appropriate action on items, if necessary, as discussed in the Closed Session. The board returned to an open session at 7:58 p.m.


